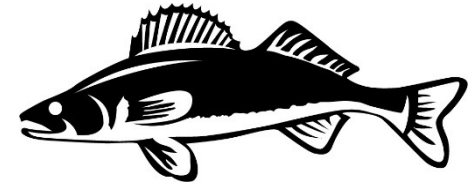
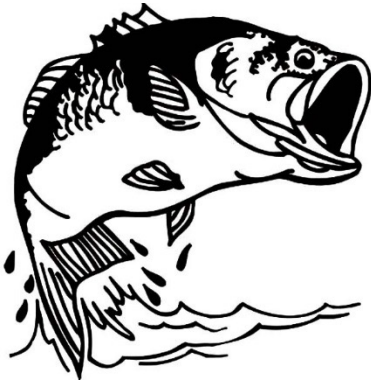


White Lake Citizens League Fall Fishing Tournament

NEW RULE: At least one person on participating boats **MUST** be a current dues paying member of the White Lake Citizens League.

All fish must be measured and weighed live so they can be released if feasible or desired.

All fish must be legal in size per M.D.N.R.

White Lake Fishing Tournament Rules and Regulations

Rules subject to change. Contact Tourney Directory for update info.

PERMITTED FISHING METHODS AND TACKLE: All fish must be caught legally in the mouth on a rod and reel. No other means of angling may be used. All fish must be caught live and in a conventional manner. Trolling and fly fishing are allowed; **No BOWFISHING** All fishermen must abide to MDNR regulations for licenses, fish size, and boating safety Tournament is open to all species of fish with the **EXCEPTION of Carp**. All fish caught must be caught on White Lake in Oakland County, Michigan.

TEAM REGULATIONS: At least one person on participating boats **MUST** be a current dues paying member of the White Lake Citizens League. WLCL dues are \$30 and will be accepted at the time of the Tournament. There is no limit to the amount of fishermen per boat (boat capacity applies).

TOURNAMENT HOURS AND REGISTRATION COSTS: Tournament registration will be from 7:00 am – 7:30 am at the White Lake Inn boat dock. Registration tournament entry cost is \$30 per boat. Tournament start is 7:30 am. Tournament ends at Noon at the docks of the White Lake Inn via air horn sound.

SCORING AND AWARDS: Only fish caught between the time of 7:30 am – Noon Saturday September 10, 2022 are eligible for prize entry. Fish must be live for measurement . All catches are judged to the discretion of the Tournament Director. All decisions are final. Combined weight of 3 largest fish per boat only for prizes regardless of the number of fish caught and people on boat. Prizes will be awarded for the following categories: Largest one fish (weight), Largest combined weight of 3 fish or less per boat (1st & 2nd places) and Special prizes: Largest walleye; Largest Fish: Youths under 13 years old. Tie breaker is overall length of largest fish. Cash prize amounts will be determined by Fishing Tournament Director, based on participation and categories.
