Woman pulled from lake by sheriff's deputy

White Lake Township police and an Oakland County Sheriff's Department Marine Division deputy were called to White Lake Sunday, Sept. 5, after a woman was observed walking along the shore of the lake and falling into the water.

The woman, a 19-year-old Highland Township resident, was pulled from the water by the Marine Division deputy. She was breathing but unresponsive at that time.

The woman was transported by ambulance to DMC Huron Valley-Sinai Hospital for medical treatment. At the hospital, her blood-alcohol level was tested and found to be 0.387 percent, more than four times the legal limit of 0.08.

All information was turned over to White Lake police for further investigation.
