Thanks to your generous donations and business contributions last year, we will celebrate the birth of our country with a larger-than-ever **Fireworks Display**, actually on the 4th of July this year. # 2009 SUMMER CELEBRATONS: "WAKESTOCK – AN ALL AMERICAN FESTIVAL"

Our social committee has decided upon a great theme for our celebrations on White Lake this season. Celebrating the 40 year anniversary of the Woodstock festival, our theme this summer will be "Wakestock - An All American Festival". This theme should give us a wide array of things to celebrate, and many boat decorating ideas for the 4th of July Boat Parade.

#### WEED CONTROL AND LAWN CARE

Last year we had two lake-wide treatments weed growth. We can add landscape ties, rocks, of the residual effects of last year's treatment.

with Sonar, which targeted two non-native or plants and bushes between our lawn and the and nuisance plants: Milfoil and Curly-Leaf lake, to serve as a barrier to block fertilizer run-Pondweed. There was also late season spot off into the lake. We can also use fertilizer that treatment targeted at the few remaining patches has 0% or low phosphorus, which is now widely of Milfoil. This year we are expecting to need available. (Phosphorus is the middle number of less treatment to control weed growth, because the 3 numbers listed on the bag of fertilizer. The first number represents Nitrogen, the second is Phosphorous, the third is Potassium or Potash.) To help in controlling aquatic weed growth, It is most likely in this area that your soil is ideally we would not fertilize our lawns, since already rich in phosphorus. The MSU Extension run-off of fertilizer contributes to weed growth in Service recommends fertilizers that are low in the lake. Most of us, however, do use fertilizer both phosphorus and potassium, such as, 23-0-6,

#### 2009 MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

We will be starting the 2009 WLCL Membership Drive by the end of April. Most lake residents will be visited by a Block Captain sometime this Spring. Please welcome this neighbor for a few minutes of conversation, and a friendly reminder of the benefits of WLCL membership.

The work is not complicated, and by starting early, you can pace yourself to make your contacts. We feel that the personal contact greatly increases our membership and donations.

The job entails contacting each resident on the list provided to you. You will:

- Solicit the residents for membership dues and fireworks donation.
- Update our roster for ownership name and address changes.
- · Collect e-mail addresses (and changes). Ask for an e-mail even if they don't want to join the WLCL. These e-mails a valuable communications tool, and are never shared with anyone else.
- Recruit anyone who would like to help with WLCL activities.
