President's Corner

A major accomplishment of 2015 was the dredging of the circular canal off the North Bay. This was identified, along with other dredging requirements and weed control, in the 1986 Lake Quality Report. That report was required to support the formation of the White Lake Improvement Board. Last year's dredging project was completed one year ahead of schedule and under budget. Placing buoys marking sunken island and the entrance to the newly dredged canal was the number 1 priority identified in a survey of lake residents, and we hope to have final government approval to install these shortly.

This year we again will start off with a great Memorial Day Pancake Breakfast. This will be followed by an even more spectacular 4th of July Fireworks Show and Boat Parades on July 2nd. There will be Coast Guard boat inspections, a Fishing Tournament, a Home Tour, and a membership drive. There will also be my favorite - Sailboat Races. Look for

me ... I'm the one who often sails with the sail pointed down!

For the 7th year, we will continue to contract with the Oakland County Sheriff's Office Marine Unit for Summer patrols on the lake. These patrols continue to make our lake a safer environment for boaters and families.

Most of what I have discussed is explained in more detail in other articles within this newsletter. I would like to thank all of the Directors and volunteers for making 2015 a great year, and 2016 an even better one. I would also like to thank our elected officials listed in the dredging article for their invaluable help in getting that job done. Lastly, I would like to thank you for your support of all of the activities on the lake.

DREDGING PROJECT

One of our most significant accomplishments in 2015 was the completion of the dredging project in the North Bay. (There is still some site landscaping and the placement of buoys marking the new channel to be completed, and some deferred payments to be made.) The area is once again open to navigation, and residents (and all lake boaters) will enjoy much-improved access this year. Remember that planning work for this project began way back in 2010. (Actually, the initial commitment was made back in 1986!)

We are extremely grateful to our dredging contractor, Gro America, for its excellent work and guidance, which helped us complete this project under budget and a year ahead of schedule.

We would like to thank nearby homeowners John and Connie Hill, Milan Reeder and Mishell McCann, and Rick Woodworth, for offering the use of their land during the project. We extend our utmost gratitude to Michigan State Senator Mike Kowall, Michigan State Representative Jim Runestad, Oakland County Commissioner Eileen

Kowall, and Rick DeVisch from the Oakland County Water Resource Commissioner's Office, who offered their constant availability and support.

None of this work would have happened without the tireless efforts of Patte Day, project manager and head of the Dredging Oversight Committee. Other valued committee members included Mike Wachsberg (who assisted us in all legal aspects), Walt Koziol (our representative to the White Lake Improvement Board and whose continued efforts kept us well under budget), Chris Kurowski (who chaired previous dredging projects), Jack Butler, Bob Parrett, Bob Pisoni, and Bill Scanlon.

Our mere words can not adequately thank WLCL President Tom DeSantis, who with the utmost professionalism, made it his mission to see that the 1986 commitment be finally fulfilled by assembling and guiding this incredible group throughout this entire process.

Finally, thanks to all of YOU, who supported this project through your Special Assessment District funds.

HOME TOUR

As long as we are able to find enough homes, the 7th Annual White Lake Home Tour will be held on Saturday, June 25th this year. As in the past, the tour will consist of a pontoon boat ride to each of the homes, wine and cheese on the boat, and guided tours of each of the homes. All proceeds benefit the WLCL fireworks.

Tickets this year will again be sold by lottery, announced in the e-newsletter and on the website (along with pictures of the homes on the tour), as the time gets closer. FISHING

The 5th Annual WLCL Fishing Tournament will be held on Saturday, June 11th from 7:00 am to 1:00 pm. Registration starts at 6:00 am at the White Lake Inn, with a \$20.00 entry fee per boat. There is no limit to the number of fishermen on a boat, but the boat owner must be a resident on White Lake. Cash prizes will be awarded based on the largest combined weight of 3 fish per boat. All of the details and rules will be available on the website. This day is part of a Michigan Free Fishing Weekend, so anyone can participate without buying a license.

PANCAKE BREAKFAST

The 9th Annual WLCL Pancake Breakfast will be held on Monday, May 30th beginning at 9:00 AM. This has become a great social event and our official kick-off to Summer. We're proud of the fact that since its commencement, the cost of \$6.00 per person has remained the same. The growth in our community, along with the expanded

participation of our members, have made this event a true success. Occasionally we have experienced some delays in getting the breakfast out in the timely fashion we once did, but we feel strongly that the event itself is well worth any wait you may experience.

NEW ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE

Thanks to our growing number of members, and your support with additional donations, we are starting to explore new activities that the WLCL can support to enhance our experience of living on White Lake. 176 people responded to the "Lake Experience Enhancement Survey" that we conducted last September. Your top choices in that survey included: Buoys on the Sunken Island (90 votes), Winter carnival (77 votes), Plowed Winter Track around the lake for cross country skiing and skating (60 votes), and Winter Fireworks Show (54 votes). You can see all of the results from the survey on our website.

We are actively pursuing approvals to install buoys to mark the Sunken Island and the newly-dredged channel from the North Bay. We hope to be able to install these this Spring.

Planning was well underway for our "First Annual White Lake Winter Carnival" last January. However... as you might remember, Mother Nature had plans of her own! Don't worry, we had lots of good ideas, and now have lots of time to plan even better activities for next Winter.

LAKE SAFETY AND COURTESY

Michigan law requires all traffic on all inland lakes to proceed in a counter-clockwise direction. There are several areas on our lake where failure to follow this rule can present a significant safety hazard to boaters towing skiers and tubes. This is probably the top concern we hear from lake residents, followed closely by the failure to maintain a "Slow, No Wake Speed" within 100 feet

of shorelines, any moored or anchored vessel, a dock or raft, or any marked swimming area or person(s) in the water. Check out the "Boating Safety & Regulations" page on the website for links to many of the Michigan regulations regarding boating on inland lakes.

ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual General Membership Meeting of the White Lake Citizens League will be held at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, May 25, 2016 at the White Lake Township offices. An important part of this meeting is the nomination and election of residents to serve a two year term on the Board of Directors. Vessel Safety Inspections

On Saturday, June 18th the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary will once again conduct Vessel Safety Checks on your watercraft at various locations around the lake. Upon passing the inspection, you will receive a 2016 VSC decal to place on your boat, alerting the sheriff patrols and others that your vessel has been inspected and has been found to be in full compliance with all federal and state boating laws.

For a complete list of inspection requirements, visit the "Boating Safety & Regulations" page of the website. In past years, this free program has booked up quickly, so we encourage all paid 2016 WLCL members to take advantage of this service by sending an e-mail to dnrliaison@wlcl.org.

Weed Treatment

Our lake weed treatment applicator has applied to the DEQ to use Fluoridone (Sonar) in treating our lake this year. In the past, this treatment has been very effective in reducing "nuisance weeds" (particularly Eurasian Milfoil and Curly-Leafed Pondweed), both in the treatment year and in the year following the treatment. It was last used in White Lake in 2008. As usual, notices will be posted on every affected property prior to the treatments. The e-newsletter and Facebook page will be used to communicate additional details as the treatments are closer.

As always, we encourage you to call the Hotline (248-887-5658) if you have specific weed or water quality concerns near your property any time during the Summer.
