  - a. Received calls for weeds in two-three locations
  - b. Dick Pinagel will evaluate Thursday and proceed with treatment as required
  - c. Additional treatment due Thursday
  - d. July 6 will be second dose of Sonar
    - i. Can swim immediately after
  - e. Spot treated with "clipper" around canals on north side
- 10) Water Quality Testing
  - a. Sean Whelan presented the 2015 CLMP report on White Lake
  - b. Trophic index was 44
  - c. Report is available online
  - d. Request to have an executive summary of 2015 report included
  - e. Joan Cooper asked how to handle riparian owners that dump hot tub into lake.
    - i. Individuals to talk to face to face with violators
  - f. Sean to request explanation from DEQ as to why Phosphorous levels are increasing given that fertilizers and detergents are phosphorous free now.
  - g. Joan Cooper reminded group that native plants along shoreline can help
