  - a. \$20,174 income since last month
    - b. \$18,862 disbursements since last month
    - c. Fireworks display for 2017 paid
    - d. Adjusting for Fireworks & Insurance monthly shift (July to June) we have \$2200 more in bank at month end 2017 vs 2016!
    - e. The winter carnival was funded,
    - f. Carol Webb moved to accept, Bill Maine seconded- unanimous pass

  - e. Bob Parrett proclaims that he will win first place with his pontoon boat.....
- 11) Merchandising
  - a. All sweatshirts sold! Total profit of \$2000
- 12) Social- Memorial Day Breakfast
  - a. Profit of \$2,186
  - b. Under budget by \$217
  - c.  $13^{th}$  consecutive year with great weather and attendance
- 13) Weed Control
  - a. \$19,035 First application
  - b. \$13630 second application
  - c. Total amount spent \$32,665 to a budget of \$65,000
  - d. Plan is to assess status in July and determine whether additional application(s) required
  - e. Algae is a continuous growth and will be a perineal
  - f. "TBD" on signage remains a concern of our riparian constituents
  - g. Dick Panela of Aqua-weed presented and took questions
    - i. 25+ years and the company has never had a claim on lawn or plant damage
    - ii. 24D
    - iii. 21 days for the most sensitive type of plant
    - iv. Will no longer be using the language "TBD"
    - v. Dick will create appropriate language that will define criteria with more specification
- 14) Water Quality Testing
  - a. No Update
- 15) Sheriff Boat Patrols
  - a. Concerned citizen complained that Sherriff is stopping too many people too often
    - i. Specific complaint that a ticket of \$170 was issued about improper MC spacing
  - b. Bob will follow up with Sherriff

  - a. Barges are loading tomorrow (June 29)
  - b. Seven Harbors has arrangements for launch access Cliff will meet and open gate for Gen X Pyrotechnics
  - c. Copy of Certificate of Insurance provided to Seven Harbors
  - d. Legal contract signed with seven harbors and WLCL
  - e. In the event of rain delay- notify Bob Parrett immediately for eminent dissemination
  - f. White Lake Township banned the use of Chinese Lanterns
