White Lake Weed Report by Frank Dyson:

Lack of Southern Diving Ducks this season has led to no weeds transported by them from other lakes.

Curly Leaf is absent this season due to prior chemical application.

Chemical application notice will appear in 2024 newsletter.

Frank encourages Canal frontage areas to limit fertilizer to reduce algae in the canals.

Wake Boat use is not being restricted by Legislature. Issue is that this type of boat causes turbulence and brings weeds to surface.

Eel Grass - Frank hopes to obtain permit to go out further than 50 feet from shore to hit Sunken Island area.

Current Lake Level monitoring by law may be discontinued by the Michigan Governor.

White Lake has a listed legal level at this time which is checked every few days at White Lake-Duck Lake Dam on White Lake. If Level is too high by listed height, Oakland County engineers open dam to let water go into Duck Lake.
